General Conditions for Participation in Tender No. Somalia/MOG/0001/2026

Tender Subject:

Modified Drilling of 40-60 deep wells equipped with solar-powered pumps in Southwest State, Somalia.

1. The bidder's activities, as stated in the commercial license, must fall within the scope of works required under this tender, and the bidder must hold all necessary licenses issued by the competent official authorities.

2. Technical Offer Requirements

The technical offer shall be submitted in a separate sealed envelope and must include the following valid documents and technical details:

2.1 Mandatory Documents

- Certificate from the Commercial Registry for construction works, indicating the registered capital.
- Commercial establishment registration.
- Commercial license indicating the nature of business activities relevant to the subject of the tender.
- Commercial registration certificate.
- Tax or Zakat clearance certificate.
- Copies of personal identification documents of the company owners or authorized signatories.

2.2 Technical Specifications Submission

The bidder must provide detailed technical information for all materials, equipment, and components related to the tender works using the table below:

Failure to fully complete the above table may result in rejection of the technical offer.

3. Full compliance with all information stated in the submitted financial offer until the expiry date of the offer's validity.
4. The validity period of the submitted offer shall not be less than ninety (90) days from the closing date.

Requirements

The financial offer shall be submitted in a separate sealed envelope and must comply with the following:

- Prices shall be quoted in United States Dollars (USD).
 - Prices shall not include any government taxes (zero-rated invoice).
 - The bidder must provide a complete financial breakdown of the offered works and supplies.
6. The bidder shall stamp and sign every page of the offer.

7. Submission of Offers

Offers shall be submitted in two sealed envelopes:

- The first envelope shall contain the Technical Offer.
- The second envelope shall contain the Financial Offer.

Each envelope must clearly indicate the tender number, tender subject, and the bidder's name.

8. The bidder shall submit a bid bond in the form of a bank guarantee or a certified bank cheque issued by one of the banks operating in Somalia, amounting to five percent (5%) of the total offer value. The bid bond shall be enclosed in a separate sealed envelope attached to the technical and financial offers, valid for ninety (90) days from the closing date and renewable.
9. The successful bidder shall replace the bid bond referred to above with a performance guarantee in the form of a bank guarantee or certified bank cheque equal to ten percent (10%) of the total contract value within one week from the official notification of award. The performance guarantee shall be valid for ninety (90) days after the expiry of the warranty or contract period and shall be renewable.
10. The performance guarantee referred to above shall later be replaced, after the full supply of materials and official and complete acceptance of the project works, with a free maintenance guarantee in the form of a bank guarantee or certified bank cheque issued in the name of the Qatar Red Crescent Society, amounting to ten percent (10%) of the awarded value. This guarantee shall be released after the expiry of the free maintenance warranty period of (90) days , provided that the supplied materials and executed works are fully functional and compliant.
11. The successful bidder shall sign a contract with the Qatar Red Crescent Society within one week from the announcement of the tender result.

12. In the event that the supplier fails or withdraws from fulfilling its obligations under these general conditions or its contractual duties, the Qatar Red Crescent Society reserves the absolute right to take the following actions:

- a. Liquidation of the submitted bank guarantees.
- b. Awarding the tender to the next lowest bidder and charging the defaulting or withdrawing supplier the price difference in addition to ten percent (10%) as administrative expenses.
- c. Blacklisting the supplier and barring it from participating in tenders for a period deemed appropriate by the Field Tender Committee at the Somalia Office.

13. The bidder shall sign and stamp these general conditions and attach them to the technical offer.

14. The Qatar Red Crescent Society is not obliged to accept the lowest-priced offer or any other offer, without providing justification.

15. The Qatar Red Crescent Society reserves the right to cancel the tender or re-tender it without providing reasons.

16. The Qatar Red Crescent Society reserves the right to increase the required quantities by up to twenty percent (20%) of the originally requested quantities or reduce the quantities based on the financial allocations approved for this tender.

17. Any offer shall be rejected if the arithmetic error exceeds five percent (5%) of the total offer value.

18. Any offer submitted after the specified deadline for submission shall not be accepted.

19. The attached technical specifications and special conditions form an integral part of these general conditions, and any offer that contradicts them shall be rejected.

20. The conditions stated in the tender announcement form an integral part of these general conditions.

21. Any offer that does not fully comply with the above-mentioned conditions shall not be considered.
